



INFORMATION RETURN FOR ELECTRONIC FILING OF AN INDIVIDUAL'S INCOME TAX AND BENEFIT RETURN

Before you complete this form, read the information and instructions on the back.

You have to complete this form to allow your electronic filer to electronically file your 2011 income tax and benefit return.

You have to complete parts A, B, and F. You choose whether you want to complete parts C, D, and E.

Your electronic filer has to complete parts G and H.

Give the signed original of this form to your electronic filer, and keep a copy for yourself.

Part A - Identification and address as shown on your 2011 return (mandatory)

Form with fields for First name and initial, Last name, Social insurance number, Mailing address, P.O. Box, R.R., City, Prov./Terr., and Postal code.

Part B - Declaration (mandatory)

Form with fields for Total income, Taxable income, Total federal non-refundable tax credits, Refund, and Balance owing.

Part C - Direct deposit (optional)

Form with instructions and fields for direct deposit information, including bank name, branch, institution number, and account number.

Part D - Alternative address authorization (optional)

Form with instructions and fields for alternative address authorization, including checkboxes for 2011 notice of assessment and tax refund.

Part E - Authorizing an electronic filer to represent you (optional)

Form with instructions and fields for authorizing an electronic filer to represent you, including a signature line and date.

Part F - Declaration and authorization (mandatory)

Form with instructions and fields for declaration and authorization, including a signature line, name and title of legal representative, and date.

Your electronic filer has to complete parts G and H (mandatory).

Form with two sections: Part G - Electronic filer identification and Part H - Document control number or confirmation number.
